

PhySoc: The Physics Society, IIT Delhi

Vision

Physics is not just a subject; it is an amalgamation of science and philosophy. From atoms to planets, from moving bicycle to bullet free jackets, from LEDs to telepathy: the involvement of Physics can be felt in each sphere of our lives. PhySoc, The Physics Society celebrates the spirit of the Physics Department of IIT Delhi and brings together all the undergraduate and post graduate students, staff and faculty together. It aims to turn the passionate students into visionaries and provide them a platform to strengthen their bonds. Believing in the all-round development of the students, PhySoc organizes a number of technical, sports, cultural events and excursions each year which prepare them for various challenges and opportunities of the world they face in future.

Constitution

1) Name of the society

The name of the society shall be PhySoc: The Physics Society, IIT Delhi.

2) Area of operation

It is an official society of the Physics Department of IIT Delhi and a formal body under Co-curricular and Academic Interaction Council (CAIC), IIT Delhi.

3) The committee

The committee shall be the governing body of the society and shall be composed of

- a) Faculty Head: He/she is the supreme authority of the society. All the decisions of the society require approval of the Faculty Head.
- b) President: The president of the society will be elected by formal elections and shall take charge for organizing various events. He/she shall be a PhD scholar who has successfully completed the comprehensive exam.
- c) Vice-president: The society will have two vice-presidents to organize technical and cultural events smoothly. The eligibility criteria for this post requires the students to be enrolled as PhD candidates.
- d) Secretary: The secretary will be the treasurer of the society who will take care of the funds. There will be two posts for the secretary, one for post-graduate and other for undergraduate students.
- e) Members: The members of the society will include ten members who will help in conducting various events. These will include 3 PhD scholars, 2 M.tech., 2 M.Sc. and 3 B.Tech. members.

The committee will be formed after a formal electoral process.

4) Responsibilities of the committee

The committee shall be responsible to fulfill the objectives of PhySoc which are:

- a) To conduct Physics quizzes
- b) To organize seminars covering diverse Physics topics
- c) To organize sports fest for the department
- d) To organize cultural fest for the department
- e) To plan trips and excursions for the students

5) Funds

The donations, grants and other money of the society shall be utilized solely for the work of the society. Secretary shall manage the funds with the consent of President and the Faculty Head.

6) Amendments

Any amendment in the constitution shall be effective only after approval of the Faculty Head.

7) Disputes

In case of any dispute arising in the society, the decision of the Faculty Head shall be final.
